Standing Committees

Standing Committees play an important role in supporting the activities of PSCA. As a member of a committee, it ensures that PSCA is implementing activities and providing resources to members based on member input and feedback. All committees assist PSCA in the following activities:

- Develop member resources, such as the Plan Sponsor Tool(k)it;
- Author articles for Defined Contribution Insights Magazine and other PSCA content;
- Assist in the creation of snapshot surveys and provide input on PSCA main surveys; and
- Produce content and provide speakers for the National Conference and webinars.

Education and Communication

Develop ideas to assist company-sponsored retirement plans in improving employee use and appreciation for their plans. This is accomplished by creating and providing access to effective, high quality communication and financial education materials for plan sponsors and participants.

Government Affairs

Promote legislative and regulatory retirement policies from the plan sponsor perspective in Washington and state/local governments. The committee frequently develops comment letters and other documents in response to legislative and regulatory activity.

Health Savings Account

Provide best practices on implementation and administration of a Health Savings Account. The committee also provides advocacy support for HSAs as part of retirement policy at the federal level.

Investment Committee

The committee focuses on investment trends, best practices, new thinking, tools, and activities pertaining to defined contribution retirement plan investments/investing and plan design.

Non-Qualified Deferred Compensation Committee

Provide insight into current trends of non-qualified deferred compensation plans, promote non-qualified plans as a resource for companies looking for other retirement vehicles and to provide advocacy support for these types of plans.

Thought Leadership Council

Service Provider focused group of individuals that collaborate to develop innovative retirement policies to improve the employer-sponsored retirement system. In addition, individual members contribute content, lead webinars, and serve in an advisory role to PSCA leadership.

The committees will partner with each other to respond to broad topics (ex. legislative and regulatory proposals; trends, best practices and development of Plan Sponsor Tool(k)it modules).
